For Residents with Municipal Trash Collection

Weekly Curbside 2 Sort Collection Information

Containers

Place in Bin



- Glass bottles/jars, all colors and sizes
- All plastic food and beverage containers labeled 
- Aluminum/tin/steel cans and lids
- Aluminum foil/pie plates
- Milk cartons and juice boxes
- **NO** broken glass, window glass, dishes, Pyrex, ceramics
- **NO** items containing paint, aerosol or hazardous materials
- **NO** plastic bags
- **NO** plastic packaging, foam, lids or toys

Paper

Place in Paper Bag



- Newspapers/inserts
- Magazines, catalogs
- Phone books, junk mail
- Office paper, shredded paper
- Paperboard (cereal, cracker boxes). Remove plastic liners
- Cardboard, flattened to 3'x3' or less to fit in truck
- Brown paper bags
- Paperback books
- **NO** pizza boxes
- **NO** plastic bags

Curbside Recycling Collection Schedule

Recycling is collected weekly on your regular trash day. Place recycling separate from trash.

Holiday Schedule

When a scheduled collection day falls on a holiday, that day's collection and all remaining collections for the week will be delayed one day. Friday's collection will be on Saturday.

Large Appliances (Curbside)

- Remove doors
- By appointment only, call (888) 870-8882
- Fee

Electronics (Curbside)

- TVs, computer monitors
- By appointment only, call (888) 870-8882
- Fee

Yard Waste (Drop-off)

- Leaves, grass, other easily raked materials
- Collection days: call (978) 957-0411 for information
- **NO** plastic bags
- **NO** branches/stumps

Christmas Trees (Drop-off)

- Remove tinsel, twine, ornaments
 - Collected during month of January.
