JOB DESCRIPTION

TREE / PARK DIVISION LABORER

Duties include any and all routine labor generally associated with Tree Department/Park Department activities and environmental maintenance operations. Included, but not limited to, are the operation of various types and sizes of lawn mowers, light tractors, and other turf maintenance equipment, pickup trucks, utility trucks, chainsaws, and skyworker/cherry pickers. The applicant shall also have a general knowledge of the maintenance and care of this equipment.

The applicant will assist the Aerial Bucket Operator with tools, ropes, and chainsaws. The applicant must have chain saw and brush chipper operation experience, knowledge of their general care, servicing and maintenance. The applicant shall be familiar with all tools and equipment associated with routine tree and forestry work.

The applicant shall be somewhat familiar with the use and application of turf fertilizers, seeding methods, soil sterilants, and various types of chemical defoliant used in the industry. The above does not singularly itemize all work activities to be encountered, but is a general description of some of the most common activities.

A valid Massachusetts CDL Class B license is required.

It is understood within the classification that the employee may be used for other duties as the need may arise when directed to do so by the Department Head or the Operations General Foreman. Availability for overtime work is mandatory when emergencies require.
