The Chairman read a letter regarding the Crosby Farm foundation which is located off of Old Road. A neighbor to this historic property was concerned with current construction in the area. After some research the Chairman determined that the current owner of the property is aware of the foundation and has no intention to destroy it. He actually would like to keep and utilize the foundation.

### **Demo Permits**

62 Arlington St. was approved under new ownership of the contractor of the construction company. This demolition permit passed on a motion of Ms. Kawa and seconded by Ms. Tremblay. Motion passed unanimously.
