

## Town of Dracut Senior Citizens Property Tax Work Off Program 2014

Eligible Senior Citizens can work in a town department for 62.5 hours and receive \$500 off their property tax bill.

To be eligible for this program an applicant must:

- Be 60 years or older
- Be a homeowner or current spouse of homeowner
- Reside in the town of Dracut
- Occupy the property for which the property taxes are paid
- Be retired and not working as of January 1, 2014
- Not be receiving any other abatement or exemption from the Town of Dracut
- Present a copy of a current property tax notice upon application to the program
- Be deemed income eligible based on the 2013 MA. State Circuit Breaker Credit Income Levels
- Present the first two pages of the 2012 Federal Income Tax 1040 form
- Total income cannot exceed: \$55,000 for a single individual who is not head of household: \$69,000 for a head of household: \$82,000 for married couples filing jointly.
- Income verification will be determined by 2012 income tax returns or if you do not file taxes a Form 4506T will need to be submitted to the IRS. 4506T Forms are available at the Dracut Council on Aging
- Participants must complete their 62.5 hours by October 31, 2014 in order to receive \$500 of their tax bills in 2015.
  
- Application period for the program will be the month of December 2013. Applications will be taken at the Dracut Council on Aging 951 Mammoth Road Dracut . M-F 8am-4pm
