

On line Voter Registration is Now Available in Massachusetts

Secretary of the Commonwealth William Francis Galvin is pleased to announce that online voter registration is available in the Commonwealth of through the portal launched by his office.

Massachusetts citizens can apply online by visiting Secretary Galvin's website @ www.sec.state.ma.us and clicking the "Massachusetts Register to Vote Online" button to access the online application system. Any Massachusetts citizen who has a valid identification card issued by the Registry of Motor Vehicles will be able to use the online system to register to vote, update their address or change their party enrollment.

Massachusetts citizens who do not have an identification issued by the Registry of Motor Vehicles can still complete an application online which they can print, sign and mail or hand deliver to their local election official (Dracut Town Clerk's Office).
