The Merrimack Valley Reliability Project (MVRP) is a new 345-kV overhead transmission line stretching from Londonderry, NH to Tewksbury, MA, which was recently approved by the Massachusetts Energy Facilities Siting Board. The MVRP is one component of the Greater Boston and New Hampshire Solution, a response to the growing demand for electricity in the Greater Boston and southern New Hampshire regions. In addition, the MVRP will produce substantial economic benefits in Massachusetts and New Hampshire, including Dracut.
