

HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE RECIPROCAL PROGRAM 2025

The Town of Dracut is pleased to provide a number of options for residents to safely dispose of household hazardous waste (HHW). We were fortunate the rain held off for the very successful HHW collection event we held at the Dillon Center on April 5, 2025. Thank you to all the residents who participated and a special note of thanks to the Department of Health and Public Works staff who assisted with the event.

In cooperation with the Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection, we have again entered into a reciprocal arrangement with a number of other communities that allows residents of each town to participate in multiple household hazardous waste collection events. If you are a Dracut resident, this means you also have the opportunity to participate in a partner town's collection event.

Registration: See Reciprocal HHW Events schedule link below for information (e.g. some communities require pre-registration). The link has each towns schedule, registration process, payment method and any exemptions.

Payment: These events are open to Dracut residents on a fee-basis. Please bring the appropriate form of payment (e.g. check) indicated in the Notes column of the schedule. Pricing is based on the host town's specific contract and will be determined by the contractor and the amount of material you bring. As an example, some contractors charge \$32 for the first 12 gallons (liquid or dry equivalent) or \$60 for 12 – 25 gallons.

Identification: You will be asked to show identification (e.g., driver's license) confirming your residency.

Thank you for your participation as the improper disposal of HHW can lead to water and air pollution, cause health and safety problems for residents and personnel (e.g. firefighters) and add unnecessary municipal costs.
