The applicant named on the One Day Application shall, at all times during which alcoholic beverages are being sold shall be available to the Licensing Authorities during all such times unless some other person similarly qualified, authorized and satisfactory to the Licensing Authorities and whose authority to act in place of such applicant shall first have been certified to the Licensing Authorities in the manner aforesaid, is present in the premises and is acting in the place of such applicant. The full names, residential address, business and home telephone numbers of said applicant must appear on the One Day Application, as well as proof that they are certified to hold such a license. Failure to have such information on file and current shall alone be sufficient cause for revocation or suspension of such license, as well as future licenses.

Licensees are responsible for ensuring that minors are not served alcoholic beverages and are not drinking alcoholic beverages on the licensed premises, whether served to them by an employee or handed to them by any other patron. All servers must be at least 18 years of age to serve.

All applicants must be of good moral character to obtain a One Day Liquor License hereunder.
